Please Note:

The training offered is for those **already in the industry** who wish to join the Association and become a NZCTWA Registered Practitioner

The New Zealand Cosmetic Teeth Whitening Association (NZCTWA) does not train newcomers into the industry, such training and mentoring is usually by the Franchisor/Licensors or equipment supplier who can train you in the use of their particular Cosmetic Teeth Whitening system.

We would advise that you do not buy a franchise *or* equipment from any supplier who does not provide such 'hands-on' training.

Your Supplier MUST be able to provide certification that they have trained you in the professional use of your equipment and the safe application of the whitening gel

The NZCTWA can provide you with a list of reputable supplier members who not only provide 'hands-on' mentoring, but who will also sponsor you through the NZCTWA Registered Practitioner Training & Registration process

THE COURSE:

The Cosmetic Teeth Whitening Practitioner Training Course is designed to provide members with comprehensive professional theoretical training in the practise of SAFE Cosmetic Teeth Whitening and is for one full day of solely theory; the onus is upon equipment & franchise vendors to provide the practical training & mentoring side of your business

The Cosmetic Teeth Whitening Practitioner Training Course is designed to provide **members** with comprehensive professional training in the practise of safe Cosmetic Teeth Whitening

Training courses operate with professional contributions of the Dentists, Chemists, Researchers & Global Teeth Whitening experts of some of the World's foremost Teeth Whitening authorities

Once the NZCTWA Cosmetic Teeth Whitening Practitioners course has been completed to the satisfaction of Association's Executive Training administrator, the member may become registered with the NZCTWA as a "NZCTWA Registered Cosmetic Teeth Whitening Practitioner"

TO QUALIFY FOR THE PRACTITIONER REGISTRATION

1. You should be a Certified Full member of the NZCTWA or have completed an Application for Certified Membership on the official NZCTWA Membership Application Form
2. You should provide certification of practical training from your equipment and whitening gel supplier as proof that you have been adequately trained by them to use your machine and apply their whitening gel professionally and safely

3. You should provide proof of theoretical training in cosmetic teeth whitening to the standards set by the Associations Code of Conduct & Practice, OR undertake the NZCTWA's Registered Practitioner Training Course
4. Providing your cosmetic teeth whitening training meets the Code of Conduct & Practice to the satisfaction of the Executive you will be awarded with the NZCTWA Registered Practitioner Certificate
5. You must be actively engaged in the Cosmetic Teeth Whitening Industry and you are Compliant with the Associations Code of Conduct & Practice
